

Petition to Form a JALT Chapter / Special Interest Group (SIG)

Pursuant to the NPO JALT Bylaw, Section V.6, “Any group petitioning for original recognition or for a change to a higher group classification must submit a Constitution that does not contradict the JALT Constitution or Bylaws.” The following will act as a provisional constitution until such group submits a constitution that is approved by the JALT Executive Board.
