Item 1 Selection of OGM chairman

JALT Vice President Nathan Furuya nominated Kip Cates as chairman of the OGM, in accordance with Article 25 of the articles of incorporation. Kip Cates's nomination was accepted unanimously.

Item 2 Selection of signatories of OGM minutes

Chairman Kip Cates nominated Kazumi Kato and Shirley Ando to serve as signatories of the minutes of the OGM. Their nominations were accepted unanimously.

Item 3 Creation of a "Senior member" type of Full membership
The motion to create a "Senior member" type of Full membership was accepted with 1,040 yeas, 32 nays, and 203 abstentions.

Item 4 Elections to the Nominations and Elections Committee

Bernadette Luyckx, Lee Arnold and David Gann were nominated by the floor to serve on the Nominations and Elections Committee. Bernadette Luyckx was elected to serve as NEC chair designate with 19 votes. Lee Arnold was elected to serve as NEC chair first alternate with 3 votes. David Gann was elected to serve as NEC chair second alternate with 2 votes.

Having completed all necessary business at the OGM, the chairman adjourned the meeting at 5:28PM.
